

# String Orchestra of Harju County, ESTONIA



The String Orchestra of Harju County, in Estonia, was created in 2003. It is composed by young musicians coming from Music Schools of the county and helps to the enrichment of cultural life in the region.

Its repertory is composed by pieces written by classical composers and composers from Northern Europe and by light music.

Since its creation, the String Orchestra has participated in many classical music festivals but also in folkloric dances and music festivals in Austria, Hungary, Sweden, Russia, Italy and Estonia.

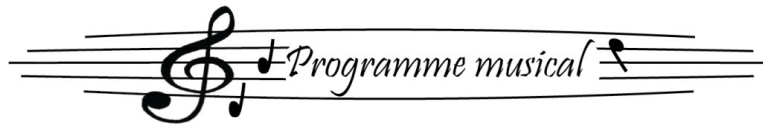
## Sirly Illak-Oluvere, conductor

Under her conducting, the Wind Orchestra of Georg Ots University has won many prestigious prizes.

In 2013, she was nominated “conductor of the year” by the Estonian Orchestra Conductor Association.
