The Georg Ots Music High School Symphony Orchestra from the city of Tallinn is an ensemble composed by students who would like to become professional musicians.

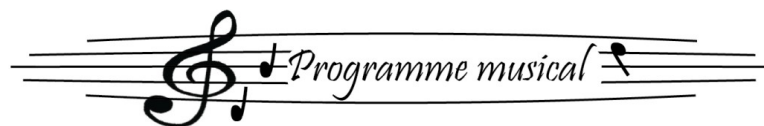
Its repertory, rich and diverse, is composed by classical music scores but also by more contemporary compositions.

Kaspar Mänd, conductor

Kaspar Mänd, native of the city of Tallinn, Estonia, has studied oboe and choir conducting. Graduated from the Estonian Academy of Music and Drama, he continued his conducting studies in 2012 at the Music Academy of Paris (France). As a choir conductor, Kaspar Mänd created the young Estonian choir “Mixed Choir HUIK” in 2009, which has won many prizes. In 2012, he was named “Young Conductor of the Year” by the Estonian Choral Association. Since 2013, he has conducted the Georg Ots Music High School Symphony Orchestra and he was selected to lead the Estonian National Opera in 2014.
